

The Pooch Paddock

Health Policies:

These requirements and suggestions are not a guarantee against infection, but an attempt to minimize the chances of contagion. The Pooch Paddock takes the safety of all dogs in our care extremely seriously and we appreciate your compliance and understanding with our requirements.

If a dog exhibits any signs or symptoms of a respiratory infection, they will immediately be put in a comfortable, isolated area until their owner can retrieve them. Dogs in the isolation ward will be cared for with fluids, potty breaks, and (when appropriate) chew toys, but will not be allowed to have any contact with other dogs. Owners (or an authorized person) will be required to pick up their dogs as soon as possible.

Dogs will be allowed back into the facility only after they have been cleared by a vet of any possible contagious infection. If owners are unable to care for their dogs during any recovery/quarantine period, arrangements must be made with The Pooch Paddock for isolated convalescent care.

Please do NOT bring your dog to daycare if they have green and/or bloody mucus from the nose or if they have a recurring cough of any kind- especially if it sounds like they “have something caught in their throat”. If your dog is exhibiting any of these symptoms, you should contact a veterinarian.

Required Vaccinations:

Rabies
Distemper – Parvo Combination Vaccine
Kennel Cough (Bordatella)
Leptospirosis
